RACE ONE: 5:00pm

3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Grade boys (combined grades for team results) 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Grade girls (combined grades for team results)

RACE TWO: 5:15pm

5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Grade boys (combined grades for team results) 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Grade girls (combined grades for team results)

**RACE THREE: 5:30pm** 

7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> GRADE GIRLS (combined grades for team results)

RACE FOUR: 5:45pm

7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> GRADE BOYS (combined grades for team results)

### **INDIVIDUAL AWARDS:**

- Wood medals for top three in each race/gender.
- Finisher ribbons for all finishers!

### **RULES/SCORING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Scoring will be done for TOP 4 in the 3/4<sup>th</sup> grade race and 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade race.
- Scoring will be done for TOP 5 in the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade race.
- Your athletes can run "up" to the next grade but not "down." For example, if you have a 6<sup>th</sup> grader that you want to run up to the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade race, they can join that race and combine to make your team. However, you CANNOT have a 7<sup>th</sup> grader run in the 5/6<sup>th</sup> grade race to make a team.
- Results are tallied by handing out PLACE CARDS to each athlete.
  - PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR ATHLETES TO BRING THESE CARDS TO THE HEAD COACH IMMEDIATELY AFTER THEIR RACE!
  - Coaches then hand results card to our results coordinator to input your team's results and tally your score.
- There will be NO individual results (ie. No times for each runner) given that this would require pre-registration to be done effectively. We continue to do this to keep the spirit of the "all-comer" and all-access approach at our meets. We have found that pre-registration limits some of our less organized, but growing, smaller teams and individuals that are just getting introduced to the sport. For some of these programs and families, access to information and time to organize is limited and we don't want to create any barriers to entry.
- We WILL have our clock running so parents and coaches can remember to view the clock as their athletes finish for their own personal record keeping! We will make additional efforts to make sure this clock is functional at the championship race!
